



# **VACATION CARE PROGRAM** 2020/2021

**RAWART NEWCASTLE** is an educational based art program that offers amazing art workshops at schools and vacation centers across the Hunter and North Coast. Our program includes a range of age-appropriate, fun, educational and hands—on art activities which run within a 70-90 minute timeframe. We work to a ratio of 1 artist per class of approx. 25 – 30 students. All materials included! Have a look at our amazing program below and let's get creative these holidays!

# YOUNGER (ages 5 - 8):

#### ARTY AUSSSIE ANIMALS (Mixed Media)

Using a variety of 2D media including paints, pastels and charcoal, students will be creating an awesome Aboriginal inspired masterpiece. We will be looking at lizards, turtles and fish, and will be using colours from nature.

# **BOBBLE HEAD BIRDS (Clay)**

Children will love making these quirky fun little birds, with their little moving bobble heads. Learn about the properties of clay and also 3D sculpture, while having fun with wire, beads, and pipe cleaners.

# LITTLE CHINESE DRAGONS (Mixed Media)

Explore the decorative and dramatic dragons of Chinese culture in this painting and drawing workshop. We will work with pens and watercolours to create a unique mythical dragon, working with oriental collage and exploring warm and cool colours.

# OLDER (ages 9 - 12):

#### TRIBAL TOTEMS (Clay)

Using multiple clay techniques, students will be able to create their very own clay tribal totem. We will discuss the cultural context of Totems in indigenous cultures, and will draw our inspiration from some of these designs looking at their imagery, markings, patterns and meanings. This workshop can be adapted to an All Ages group.

## **MEDIEVAL GARGOYLES (Clay)**

Students will learn how to use clay to construct a 3D Gargoyle design inspired by medieval time. We will also be learning some simple painting techniques. This workshop can be adapted to an All Ages group.

# **FUTURISTIC PORTRAITS (Mixed Media)**

We will draw inspiration from Australian artist Del Kathryn Barton and her highly decorative portraits in this mixed media workshop. We will use lots of colour, texture and pattern to create some stunning face designs.

# ALL AGES (5yrs +)

# SEA CREATURES (Clay)

Students will learn how to manipulate clay using their hands to create a range of 3D shapes, and how to construct a sea animal design (penguin, whale etc.) We will also be learning some simple painting techniques. A fun activity that is suited for all ages.

### **DINOSAURS ROAR (Clay)**

Using our amazing air-drying clay, students will learn how to create a range of 3D shapes from which they can design their own dinosaur sculpture. There are multiple designs available with differing levels of difficulty therefore suited for all ages.

## **COMPLIMENTARY COLOUR FACES (Clay)**

Learn all about clay and working with slabs in this fun workshop. Students will be guided through creating their own mask design and then working with paints to decorate. We will discuss complimentary colour theme ideas to create bold face designs.

### **NATIVE FLORA ART (Mixed Media)**

A fantastic workshop exploring the shapes, textures and colours of our own Aussie native flora such as Banksias, Grevilleas, Gumnuts, and Wattle. We will work with pens and watercolours to create beautiful native artworks.
